



Materials:

Spud & Chloë Outer (100g/60yds): 3 hanks in Wave #7217

Size 13 (9mm) 16" circular needle, or size needed to obtain gauge

1 Stitch marker

Tapestry needle

Gauge:

In Chevron stitch, 11 sts and 16 rows = 4"

Pattern:

Using long-tail method, cast on 80 sts. Place marker to indicate beginning of round and join, being careful not to twist.

Begin working in Chevron pattern. The chart (or written instructions) represent 1/10th of the sts on needle. You will repeat each row of chart 10 times each round.

Work rows 1-16 2 times total, then work rows 1-8 once more.
Bind off all sts.

Block piece using steam or by spritzing with water and laying flat to dry.

Simple Chevrons pattern:

- Row 1: p7, k1
- Row 2: p7, k1
- Row 3: k1, p5, k2
- Row 4: k1, p5, k2
- Row 5: k2, p3, k3
- Row 6: k2, p3, k3
- Row 7: k3, p1, k4
- Row 8: k3, p1, k4
- Row 9: k7, p1
- Row 10: k7, p1
- Row 11: p1, k5, p2
- Row 12: p1, k5, p2
- Row 13: p2, k3, p3
- Row 14: p2, k3, p3
- Row 15: p3, k1, p4
- Row 16: p3, k1, p4
