



Finished Measurements

Width: 60"

Depth: 18"

Gauge

In Stockinette stitch, 21 sts and 32 rows = 4", after blocking

Special Abbreviations

BO: bind off

CC: contrast color

CO: cast on

k: knit

k2tog: knit two stitches together

kfb: knit into the front and back of the next st

m: marker

M1L: make one left (use tip of left needle to lift the bar that runs between the stitch just knit and the next on the left needle, from front to back; knit it through the back loop)

M1R: make one right (use tip of left needle to lift the bar that runs between the stitch just knit and the next on the left needle, from back to front; knit it through the front loop)

MC: main color

p: purl

pm: place marker

RS: right side

sm: slip marker

slwyib: slip with yarn in back (slip stitch as if to purl while holding working yarn to the back)

slwyif: slip with yarn in front (slip stitch as if to purl while holding working yarn to the front)

ssk: slip, slip, knit (slip next two stitches, one-by-one, as if to knit; insert tip of left needle from left to right into the fronts of these two stitches and knit them together)

sts: stitches

WS: wrong side

yo: yarn over

Materials

- Spud & Chloë Fine (65g/248yds): 1 hank MC, 1 hank CC1, 1 hank CC2
 - Size 5 (3.75mm) 36" circular needle, or size needed to obtain gauge
 - Size 8 (5mm) needle, for working BO
 - Stitch marker
 - Tapestry needle
- Photo Shown: Lipstick #7810 (MC), Hippo #7823 (CC1), Goldfish #7817 (CC2)

Pattern Note

Shawl is knit from the center-top down in one piece. Be careful not to work your edge increases too tightly so the top of the shawl remains stretchy for proper blocking.

When working the Dot Slipped Stitch Pattern it is not necessary to break your MC yarn. When carrying your non-working yarn along the selvedge edge be sure to twist it together with the working yarn every RS row for a tidy edge.

Shawl

Setup

With MC, CO 3 sts and k six rows. Three garter ridges.

Next row (RS): k3, rotate work 90° clockwise, and pick up and k3 sts along the selvedge edge (one in each garter ridge). Rotate work 90° clockwise again and pick up and k1 st in each CO st. [9 sts]

Section 1

Row 1 (WS): k2, kfb, p2, pm, p1, kfb, k2. [11 sts]

Row 2 (RS): k2, kfb, k to m, M1R, sm, k1, M1L, k to last 3 sts, kfb, k2. Four sts increased.

Row 3 (WS): k2, kfb, p to last 3 sts, kfb, k2. 2 sts increased. Rep the last two rows 52 times. [323 sts]

Dot Slipped St Pattern

Join CC1.

Row 1 (RS): with CC1, k2, kfb, sl2wyib, (k4, sl2wyib) to m, M1R, sm, k1, M1L, (sl2wyib, k4) to last 5 sts, sl2wyib, kfb, k2. [327 sts]

Row 2 (WS): k2, kfb, p1, (sl2wyif, p4) to 4 sts before the m, sl2wyif, p2, sm, p1, (sl2wyif, p4) to 6 sts before the end of the row, sl2wyif, p1, kfb, k2. [329 sts]

Row 3: k2, kfb, k2, sl2wyib, (k4, sl2wyib) to 1 st before the m, k1, M1R, sm, k1, M1L, k1, (sl2wyib, k4) to 7 sts before the end of the row, sl2wyib, k2, kfb, k2. [333 sts]

Row 4: k2, kfb, p3, (sl2wyif, p4) to 5 sts before the m, sl2wyif, p3, sm, p2, (sl2wyif, p4) to 8 sts before the end of the row, sl2wyif, p3, kfb, k2. [335 sts]

Row 5: with MC, k2, kfb, k to m, M1R, sm, k1, M1L, k to last 3 sts, kfb, k2. [339 sts]

Row 6: k2, kfb, p to last 3 sts, kfb, k2. [341 sts]

Row 7: with CC2, k2, kfb, k3, sl2wyib, (k4, sl2wyib) to m, M1R, sm, k1, M1L, (sl2wyib, k4) to last 8 sts, sl2wyib, k3, kfb, k2. [345 sts]

Row 8: k2, kfb, (p4, sl2wyif) to 2 sts before the m, p2, sm, p1, (sl2wyif, p4) to last 3 sts, kfb, k2. [347 sts]

Row 9: k2, kfb, k1, (k4, sl2wyib) to 1 st before the m, k1, M1R, sm, k1, M1L, k1, (sl2wyib, k4) to last 4 sts, k1, kfb, k2. [351 sts]

Row 10: k2, kfb, p2, (p4, sl2wyif) to 3 sts before the m, p3, sm, p2, (sl2wyif, p4) to last 5 sts, p2, kfb, k2. [353 sts]

Rows 11 and 12: with MC, rep rows 5 and 6. [359 sts]

Rows 13 - 16: with CC1, rep rows 1-4. [371 sts]

Picot Hem

Row 1 (RS): with MC, k2, kfb, k to m, M1R, sm, k1, M1L, k to last 3 sts, kfb, k2. [375 sts]

Row 2 (WS): k2, kfb, p to last 3 sts, kfb, k2. [377 sts]
Rep the last two rows twice more. [389 sts]

Row 7: (k2tog, yo) to m, sm, k1, (yo, k2tog) to end of row.

Row 8: k3, p to last 3 sts, k3.

Row 9: k2, ssk, k to 2 sts before the m, ssk, sm, k1, k2tog, k to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2. [385 sts]

Row 10: k2, k2tog, p to last 4 sts, ssk, k2. [383 sts]

Finishing

To BO: Using larger ndl in your right hand, work as foll: k2, sl the first st over the second st, ssk, sl the second st over the ssk. BO knitwise until 4 sts rem on the left ndl, k2tog, sl the st on the right over the k2tog, BO rem sts.

Fold the hem under (so that the eyelet row forms a picot edge at the hem) and, using a whip st, sew the BO edge to the WS of the shawl. The BO will line up with the first row of MC after the Dot Slipped Stitch Pattern was finished. Be sure to sew the hem evenly, leaving enough elasticity for blocking.

Block and weave in ends. Blocking wires are recommended for the picot hem.
