

## Cap Sleeve Wrap

## CENTER BACK PANEL

Loosely ch 42 (43, 44, 45, 46). This chain forms the center back of the vest. Stitches will be worked outwardly from both sides of this chain. Flip chain over and find the "bump" in the middle of each st. Work the first row into this bump.

If you would like a longer vest, just make this chain longer and add the number of new sts to the totals in the rest of the instructions.

**Row 1**: Hdc in the 3rd ch from the hook and in each chain across [40 (41, 42, 43, 44) sts]

Ch 2 and turn. The ch 2 is not counted as a stitch.

Rows 2-6 (2-6, 2-6, 2-7, 2-7): Hdc in the 1st st and in each st across row.

Ch2 2 and turn.

Break yarn and end off.

Flip piece over to work into the opposite side of the starting chain. Join yarn in the remaining strands of the 1st ch.

**Row 1:** Ch 2 and hdc in the same st. Hdc in the remaining chains. Count sts to make sure you have the same number [40 (41, 42, 43, 44) hdc] Ch 2 and turn.
