#### EXPERIENCE LEVEL

- Intermediate

#### MATERIALS

- Woolstok (Worsted) Bundle (100% Fine Highland Wool, 27 mini hanks: 5g/12yds each): 1 bundle (27 Color)
- Size 7 (4.5mm) 16" circular needle, or size needed to obtain gauge
- Stitch marker
- Tapestry needle

#### SIZE

- One

#### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

- Circumference: 22"
- Length: 17½"

#### GAUGE

- In charted pattern, 26 sts and 27 rnds = 4" unblocked

#### ABBREVIATIONS

<u>BO:</u>	<u>bind off</u>
<u>CO:</u>	<u>cast on</u>
<u>k:</u>	<u>knit</u>
<u>patt:</u>	<u>pattern</u>
<u>p:</u>	<u>purl</u>
<u>pm:</u>	<u>place marker</u>
<u>rep:</u>	<u>repeat</u>
<u>rnd(s):</u>	<u>round(s)</u>
<u>st(s):</u>	<u>stitch(es)</u>
<u>*</u> :	<u>repeat the directions between the asterisks as many times as indicated.</u>

#### STITCH PATTERNS

K2, P2 RIB (MULTIPLE OF 4 STS):

ALL RNDs: \*k2, p2; rep from \* to end.

#### SPECIAL METHODS

##### STRANDED COLOR:

A method of color knitting in which two or more yarns are worked at the same time, with yarns not in use stranded loosely across the wrong side of the piece.

**NOTES:** In order to stay within the specified yarn amounts (1 mini hank per color), use long tail cast on, check your gauge frequently throughout the project and leave tails between 3 and 5".

#### COWL

##### RIB

With C1, CO 120 sts, pm, and join in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts.

Work 3 rnds in K2, P2 Rib.

##### FINISHING

Weave in all ends. Block to finished dimensions.
