MATERIALS

- Woolstok (Worsted) Bundle (100\% Fine Highland Wool, 27 mini hanks: $5 \mathrm{~g} / 12 \mathrm{yds}$ each): 1 bundle ( 27 Color)
- Size 7 (4.5mm) 16" circular needle, or size needed to obtain gauge
- Stitch marker
- Tapestry needle

SIZE

- One

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

- Circumference: 22"
- Length: 17½"

GAUGE

- In charted pattern, 26 sts and 27 rnds $=4^{\prime \prime}$ unblocked

## STITCH PATTERNS

K2, P2 RIB (MULTIPLe Of 4 STS):
ALL RNDS: *k2, p2; rep from * to end.

## SPECIAL METHODS

STRANDED COLOR:
A method of color knitting in which two or more yarns are worked at the same time, with yarns not in use stranded loosely across the wrong side of the piece.

NOTES: In order to stay within the specified yarn amounts (1 mini hank per color), use long tail cast on, check your gauge frequently throughout the project and leave tails between 3 and $5^{\prime \prime}$.

## COWL

RIB
With C1, CO 120 sts, pm, and join in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts.

Work 3 rnds in K2, P2 Rib.

## FINISHING

Weave in all ends. Block to finished dimensions.
